Before coming to MITRE, Swartout served as the Chief of Staff to the Secretary of the Air Force and was a member of the Senior Executive Service. In the Air Force he also served as Senior Advisor to the Secretary of the Air Force and the Under Secretary of the Air Force.

In 2015, Swartout was the Spokesperson and Senior Advisor to the Secretary of Defense during Ash Carter's Senate confirmation and transition back to the Pentagon.

Prior to joining the Air Force Secretariat, Swartout served as a Senior Advisor in the Public Affairs Office of the Secretary of Defense and as the Spokesperson for Deputy Secretaries of Defense Ash Carter and Christine Fox.

Before joining the Pentagon in 2009, Mr. Swartout advised clients on issues of crisis communications and external relations at one of Washington, D.C.'s premier strategic communications firms .

In addition to his experience in the Pentagon and the private sector, Mr. Swartout has served as the Associate Director of the Truman National Security Project and as a congressional aide to U.S. Senator Max Baucus.
